



## Affordable Connectivity Program Helping Households Connect

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is an FCC program that helps families and households connect to affordable internet service.

### ACP provides:

- Up to \$30/month discount for broadband service;
- Up to \$75/month discount for households on qualifying Tribal lands; and
- A one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet purchased through a participating provider if the household contributes more than \$10 but less than \$50 toward the purchase price.

ACP is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

### Am I Eligible?

A household is eligible for ACP if the household income is at or below 200% of the [Federal Poverty Guidelines](#), or if a member of the household meets at least one of the criteria below:

- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income internet program;
- Participates in one of these assistance programs:
  - SNAP
  - Medicaid
  - Federal Public Housing Assistance
  - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
  - WIC
  - Veterans Pension or Survivor Benefits
  - Free/Reduced-Price School Lunch Program
  - or [Lifeline](#)
- Participates in one of these assistance programs and lives on [Qualifying Tribal lands](#):
  - Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance
  - Tribal TANF
  - Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations
  - Tribal Head Start (income based)

### Two-Steps to Enroll

1. Go to [AffordableConnectivity.gov](https://AffordableConnectivity.gov) to submit an application or print out a mail-in application; and
2. Contact your preferred participating provider to select a plan and have the discount applied to your bill.

Some providers may have an alternative application that they will ask you to complete.

Eligible households must **both apply for the program and contact a participating provider to select a service plan.**

  - \$30 or less

  - Data: 150GB or 1TB based on type and speeds available
  - No installation fee and no charge for in-home Wi-Fi modem
  
- **PCs for People**
  - \$15/month
  - For more information, call: (877) 450-8585
  - Data: Unlimited
  - 3 pre-paid plans available: 3 months of service (\$45 at \$15/month); 6 months of service (\$85 at \$14.16/month); 12 months of service (\$135 at \$11.25/month)
  
- **Spectrum Internet Assist**
  - \$17.99/month
  - For more information, call: (844) 525-1574
  - Data: No data caps, free modem, and free Internet Security Suite protection
